The intent of the Invitation for Bid is to seek competitive proposals for the replacement/repairs of a 2008 Autocar Garbage truck's engine # 46810912 ISL 365hp CPL 3792 and delivery to the City of Jasper Sanitation Department as specified on the attached bid documents.

Separate, sealed bids for **Replacement of Engine for 2008 Autocar** for the Sanitation Department will be received by the **Purchasing Department, 400 19th St W, Jasper, Alabama, until Monday, May 1, 2017 at 11:30 a.m.**, and then, at said office, be publicly opened and read aloud.

The Contractor is prohibited from assigning, transferring, conveying, subletting, or otherwise disposing of this agreement or its rights, title or interest therein or its power to execute such agreement to any other person, company or corporation without the prior consent and approval in writing by the City.

TWO (2) COPIES OF BIDS MUST BE SUBMITTED.

Bidder must comply with the following:

- Include a ten (10%) percent bid bond, or a certified check, made payable to the City of Jasper or letter of credit with your bid submission, if the amount of your bid is \$50,000.00 or over.
- Certificates of Insurance required **shall** be furnished to the Department of Public Purchases, City Hall, 400 19th Street West, Jasper, Alabama 35501 and must be shown as issued to the City of Jasper as additional insured.

The City of Jasper reserves the right to:

- Reject any and all bids in whole or in part or to waive any informality in bidding if it is determined to be in the best interest of the City of Jasper.
- Verify payment of all real and personal property taxes by the Contractor prior to the award of any contract renewal.
- The City reserves the right to add or delete quantities as required by the City
- Make awards not based solely on low bids when time is a critical factor.
- Reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to decline to make an award.
- Award a contract resulting from the solicitation to the responsible vendor(s) whose offer, conforming to the solicitation, will be most advantageous to the City of Jasper terms of cost, price, and other factors specified elsewhere in this solicitation.

Firm price for the length of the bid unless there is a materially dramatic and reasonably unanticipated change in the market. The City of Jasper may entertain a request for a price change (increase or decrease) upon a written request submitted together with details of reasoning and accompanied by supporting documentation to substantiate the request. If the City of Jasper agrees to a price change, but the amount of the change is in dispute, the price may then be negotiated with the Purchasing Agent.

No Bidder shall furnish goods, services, or construction under the contract award until a Purchase Order has been issued by the Purchasing Department.

It is hereby understood, agreed and acknowledged that upon award to the successful bidder the undersigned bidder shall be bound and obligated to perform for the City of Jasper in accordance with the Terms, Obligations, Conditions, and Specifications as set forth in this bid and the Invitation to Bid. Any changes, revisions or alterations to the contract's Terms, Conditions, and Requirements herein shall deem this document to be null and void. **This bid and the Invitation to Bid shall be an enforceable contract between the City and the undersigned bidder.**

Bid Submission: Sealed bids must be received and time-stamped by the Purchasing Department prior to bid closing time. No bid received after bid-closing time will be considered.

Late Bids: It shall be the sole responsibility of the bidder to pay for any type of delivery service charge, and to see that the Office of the Purchasing Agent receives his/her bid on time. The clock used shall be the Purchasing Agent's official date and time stamp clock. The City does not assume financial responsibility for late deliveries by the U.S. Postal System or any other delivery service.

If your envelope is not marked accordingly, the City will not assume responsibility.

INTENT OF SPECIFICATIONS:

It is the intent of these specifications to cover the repair/replacement of Autocar Engine ISL 365hp, a 2008 Autocar Garbage Truck. **Engine #46810912, CPL 3792 and ISL 365HP.**

We are looking for competitive bids that incorporate an evaluation of the engine, and details the repairs proposed. The bid must contain specific details of all repairs, including listing parts to be replaced and parts to be refurbished, labor, materials, and any other expense. Bids must include pick up of vehicle at the Jasper Sanitation Department or its current location at Midsouth (2200 Pinson hwy 79, Birmingham, AL 35217), and return delivery of the vehicle back to the Jasper Sanitation Department and an estimated timeline of the work from date of pickup to date of return.

Bidders shall indicate in the "yes/no" columns on the right side of each page, if their bid complies on each item (PARAGRAPH) specified. Exceptions may be allowed if they are equal to or superior to that specified and provided they are individually listed and fully explained on a separate page, attached to their bid. Failure to submit these statements or to provide documentary evidence of claimed compliance, if requested to do so, may disqualify the bid. If the system will meet the requirement in the future, indicate revision or version number and date available.

The word “**must**” is used in this document to define requirements that are *critical. Non-compliance will result in disqualification of a bid.* Suppliers will be expected to *provide* all items with **must** in the description. Partial bids, i.e. those which do not offer all requested elements, will not be considered.

➤ **WORK SPECIFICATIONS:**

All bidders must inspect the vehicle prior to submitting a quote. Arrangements for inspecting the vehicle must be made through Acting Superintendent of Sanitation, Jon Geddings, available by telephone at 205-221-8519.

If bidder proposes to replace items with a different make or model, the bidder must supply documentation that the replacement is equal to or better than the make and model of the original equipment being replaced.

- a. Engine must come with a 5 year extended warranty.
- b. Bidder must have at least five years of experience in performing work on Autocar Garbage Trucks. Bidder will list all municipalities for which they have done work in the past five years.

- c. Bidder must supply at least five references from other municipalities in Alabama who have had similar apparatus repairs in the past five years.
- d. All repairs shall follow Autocar's Shop Repair Service Manual requirements concerning computer, electrical, and other components which need to be disabled during repairs.
- e. Bidder is responsible for all damage to equipment on the vehicle due to not properly following Autocar's Shop Repair Service Manual requirements.
- f. Bidder must demonstrate they have a facility to repair the 2008 Autocar Engine. This shall include photographs of the facility clearly showing that the facility has the ability to accommodate an Autocar Garbage Truck.
- g. The repair work must be completed within 45 calendar days from day of pick up at the Jasper Sanitation Department to day of return delivery to the Jasper Sanitation Department, inclusive.
- h. Every day over 45 days that the work is not complete and vehicle delivered will cost the successful bidder \$100 per day.
- i. Autocar Garbage Truck will be picked up and delivered to the Jasper Sanitation Department, 1311 West Gamble Dr, Jasper, Alabama.
- j. Bidder must note any past or pending bankruptcy petition on file for their business. If there is none, that shall be stated.
- k. A copy of liability insurance in the amount of \$500,000 or more will be presented upon request.

It is the City of Jasper Purchasing Department's policy to reduce current and future business costs wherever possible. The Purchasing Agent, in its sole discretion, will make a recommendation to the City Council to award a contract resulting from this solicitation to the responsible vendor whose offer, conforming to the solicitation, will be most advantageous to the City of Jasper Sanitation Department, cost, price, and other factors specified elsewhere in this solicitation, considered. The City of Jasper reserves the right to accept any bid, in its sole discretion, or any part thereof, or reject any or all bids.
