SPECIFICATIONS

GENERAL

This is to establish a contract for acquisition of dual wall polyethylene pipe that will be used by the City of Jasper. The contract period shall be for a twelve-month period from the date of the contract award with an option to issue a second and third contract with the same pricing, terms and conditions and agreement by both parties for a second and third twelve-month periods. The total quantity of purchases under the contract is not known. Orders will be placed, as the City of Jasper has need with no minimum order requirements accepted.

The total quantity of purchases under the contract is not known. Orders will be placed, as the City of Jasper has need. Any rebates/ incentives offered by the manufacturers after the bids have been opened will be passed to the City of Jasper. All bids can be held for a period of sixty days after bid opening before awarding the contract. Bids will be evaluated by item and/or total and may be awarded by item, group or total whichever is in the best interest of the City. The City of Jasper will reserve the right to reject any and all bids.

The City will require successful bidder to be able to supply the following type of dual wall polyethylene pipe:

HDPE-meets or exceeds specifications set forth in AASHTO M294, Type S

All pipe supplied under this contract must be fabricated from HDPE (high density polyethylene) and meet all applicable Alabama Department of Transportation specifications. Products supplied under this contract shall be subject to laboratory tests if the City of Jasper deems necessary at the Vendor's expense. Please bid dual wall polyethylene pipe between the sizes of 12" – 60" diameter.

All bidders must submit bid using a percentage discount from a per foot price list. All bid discount rates must include delivery costs. All bidders must indicate which price list corresponds to the bid items listed above. Maximum acceptable delivery time will be seven (7) calendar days after receipt of order unless City representative agrees to extension of time.

The City reserves the right to waive minor variances from the specifications, provided these differences do not violate the specification intent, materially affect the operation for which the item or items are being purchased, or materially change the scope of the work specified, nor increase the estimated maintenance and repair cost to the City.

Bid will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. The determination of lowest responsive and responsible bidder may involve all or some of the following factors: price, conformity to specifications, financial ability to meet the contract, previous performance, facilities and equipment, availability of repair parts, experience, delivery promise, compatibility as required, other costs, or other objective and accountable factors which are reasonable.

All requests for interpretation of any portion of bid may be made by telephone to Derleda Abrom, the City Purchasing Agent, at (205) 221-2100. All replies will be given verbally and a copy of any inquiry and advise, if deemed vital by Purchasing Agent, will be made available to each prospective bidder.

All bids/proposals shall be submitted in the form and manner indicated by the bid documents and bid forms. Any

bid /proposal which is not submitted in form and manner indicated which contains information, statements, conditions, or qualifications which place conditions or qualifications on the proposal submittal for the purposes of making an award, or which alter any proposal terms, conditions specifications, or forms, which have not been previously by written addendum from Purchasing Agent, or which does not meet legal requirements, shall be declared as a qualified, conditional, or non-responsive and shall be rejected. Any proposals that do not fully respond to all detailed specifications or requests for information including execution of proposal forms may be declared “non-responsive” and recommended for rejection

Contractor will be considered in default of contract if/when they have not delivered the before mentioned product for a period of two consecutive scheduled dates. Any disputes over the interpretation and and/or performance of conditions or responsibilities shall be resolved at sole discretion of City Purchasing Agent.

The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informality in the bidding.
